1. All Travel Coaches:

- 1) Coaches –B.G.H.A. approved jacket**
- 2) Trainers – B.G.H.A approved jacket**
(All coaches and trainers must also wear black pants, as the case may be, if they will be on the bench or in photos.)

Note: It is strongly encouraged that the coaches maintain as much continuity in their dress; i.e., all coaches on the bench should wear the same jacket. This will provide for good B.G.H.A. and team representation, as well as provide the best results for team photos in the even of tournament/championship wins and ultimately, any submissions to the media of team photos.
